(1) The National Maritime Museum (48)

The National Maritime Museum was built in 1656, from a designby the city architect Daniël Stalpaert. The building originally served as a maritime warehouse, in which materials needed for the shipping industry were stored. It has been home to the Dutch National Maritime Museum since 1973. The National Maritime Museum houses one of the most important maritime collections in the world.Here, you can see world-famous atlases and maps among other things.



(1) 'Huis ten Bosch' Palace (52)

This large country residence is the palace where King Willem-Alexander and his family live. It was built around 1645, from a design by Pieter Post. In 1735, large alterations were carried out on the two side wings, under the direction of Daniël Marot. After the Second World War, the gardens of the palace were completely restored. Palace Huis ten Bosch is being renovated between 2015 and 2017. The King and his family will relocate to Palace Huis ten Bosch once the renovation works have been completed.
